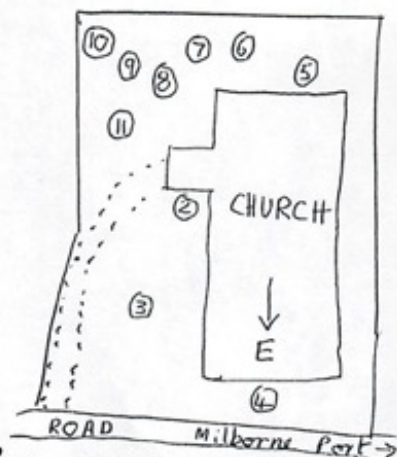

Church(Interior).

- 1). Marble wall plaque(in the nave). To the glory of God and in grateful remembrance of James John YOUNG, who for 43 years was tenant of Pinford Farm, during which time he acted as Churchwarden, and gave the oak pulpit and reading desk. This tablet was erected by F.J.B. WINGFIELD DIGBY, of Sherborne Castle. Also as a record of thanks to his widow, who, in memory of her husband and daughter, refloored and re-seated the whole of the nave and fixed the wood dado round it. 1912.

BURIAL GROUND.

- 2). Headstone. Flaked and illegible, apart from a piece giving the stonemason's name: "J. THO (MAS?), Sherb(orne?)".
- 3). Headstone. In affectionate remembrance of John GILLARD, who died Dec: 1, 1863, aged 60. Also of Martha Gillard, who died June 2, 1885, aged 72.
- 4). Four Urns on pedestals at the corners of a square of grass, with two mounds in centre. No curb, or inscriptions.
- 5). Headstone and Curb. In loving memory of our dear daughters, Ivy May LANE, who died September 20th, 1923, aged 25 years. Also of Victoria Maud Elizabeth LANE, who died June 4th, 1907, aged 7 years. Interred at Thornford. Also in loving memory of Benjamin Lane, father of the above, a beloved husband of Rose Ann Lane, who passed peacefully away December 22nd, 1939, aged 67 years. Also of Rose Ann Lane, who died October 31st, 1948, aged 81 years.
- 6). Cross. In ever loving memory. Gwendolin Marguerite DAVIS, born December 12, 1901, died January 12, 1918. Ivor Franklin Sellick Davis. Died at Aldershot, March 29, 1916, in his 20th. year. Jess Frank Davis, fell in action October 26, 1917, in his 20th. year. Also of Emily, the beloved wife of Frank Davis, who died March 28, 1940, aged 69.
- 7). Headstone. In memory of Maria BAILEY. Died November 23, 1887, aged 67 years.
- 8). Cross. In loving memory of William CUTLER, who died April 11th, 1921, aged 60 years. Also of his beloved wife Sarah, who died April 25th, 1938, aged 83 years.
- 9). Headstone. In memory of Jesse SHEPHERD, died April 21, 1875, aged 53 years.
- 10). Urn (of modern date, c. 1950's?). In remembrance of Arthur (Art), aged 17 years.
- 11). Headstone. In loving memory of William WARREN, who died February 13th, 1882, aged 63 years. Mary Ann, his wife, died October 26, 19 aged 82 years.

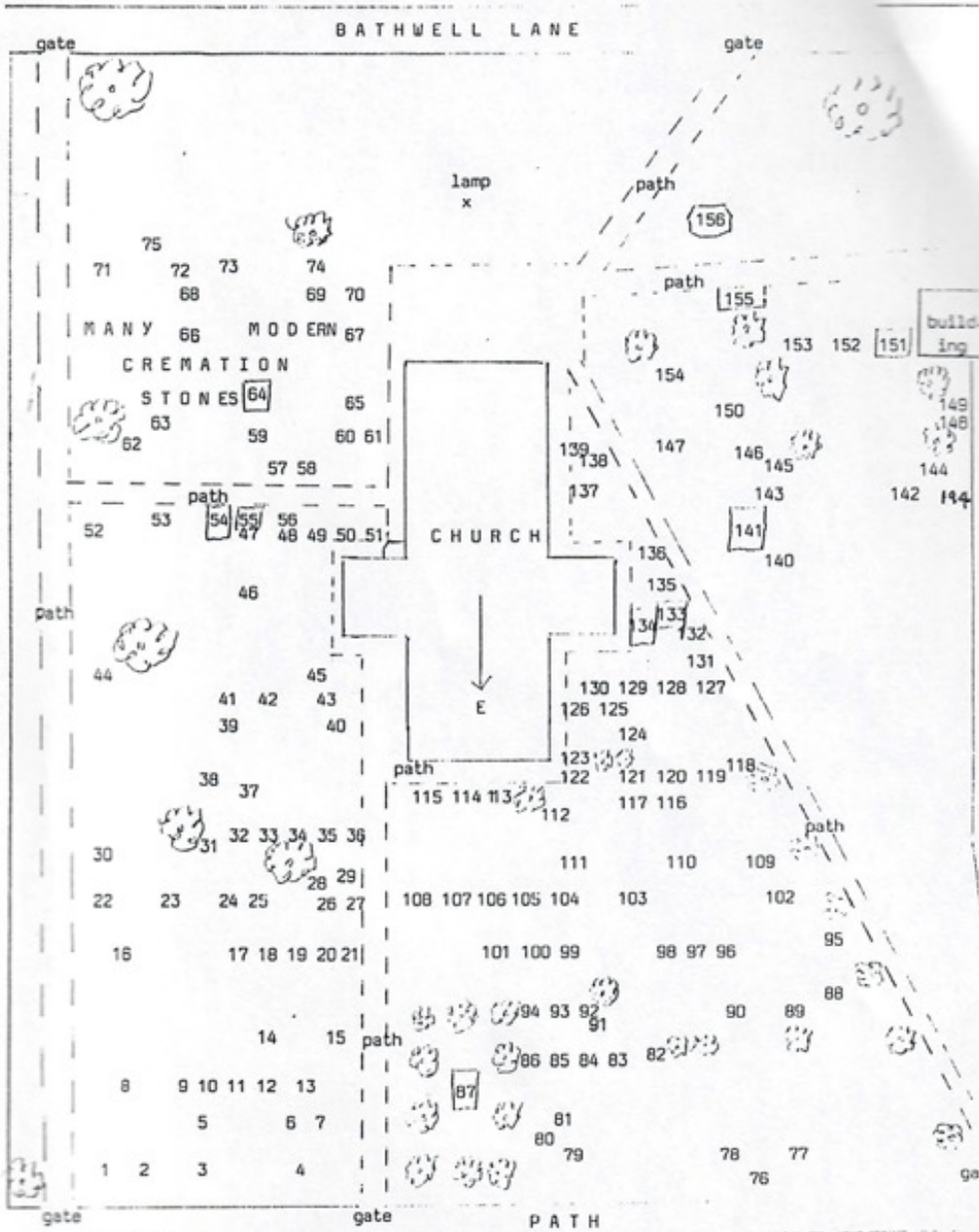
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MILBORNE PORT, SOMERSET: Parish Church. Rough Plan of Churchyard.

All stones before 1964 are recorded, though there are few dating after 1901, when the churchyard was full and the cemetery was opened; the only ones dating after 1901, apart from relatives of those already buried here, are a group of 'infill' burials of cremated remains in the south-west part of the burial ground. The modern cremation stones (in 1987 totalling 79 stones dated between 1964 and 1987) have not been recorded.

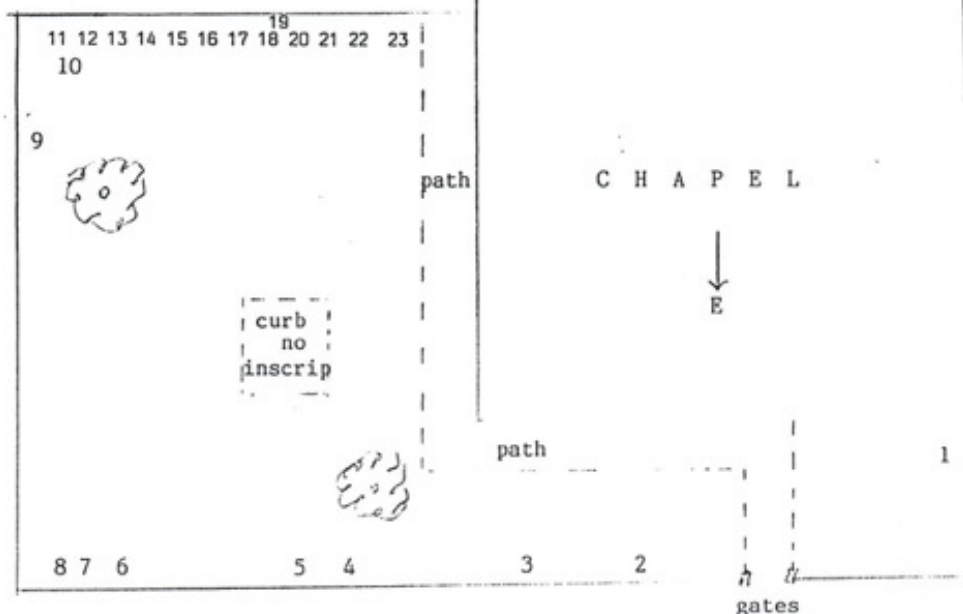

UNITED REFORMED CHAPEL, CHAPEL LANE, MILBORNE PORT: Monumental Inscriptions.

This Congregation was founded in 1662, the first chapel being built on this site in 1749, rebuilt 1844. (called in 1837 "The Old Meeting", Milborne Port). Inscriptions checked with burial register, 1780-1837, at PRO/RG4/1751, and with burial register in chapel, 1854-1909.

All stones recorded, except 4 cremation stones between No.1, and the path, which are dated between 1977 and 1987. Clearly the stones have been rearranged around the perimeter to ease maintenance; this has left a curb in the grass in the centre without its attendant headstone.

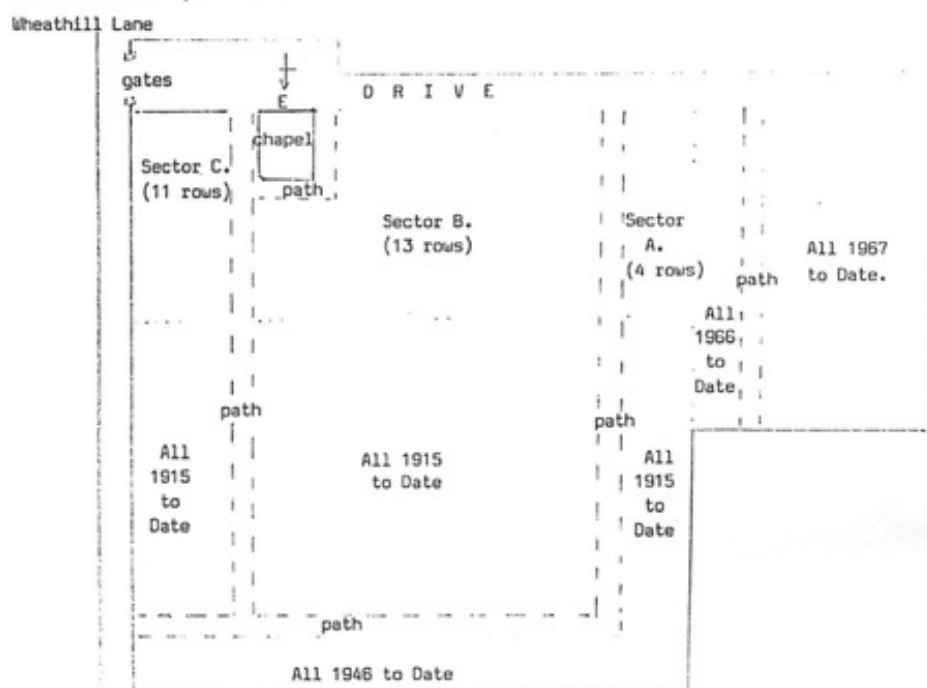
