

# Henry Raymond – 1826 – Milborne Port

1841 Census Location - Plot 312 – House and Garden - 26 Perches (657.6m2)

Google Co-ordinates 50°58'01.6"N 2°27'46.5"W

Looks like Original House is gone

My cousin has pinpointed the location of the Raymond residence in Gunville Street where my 3x great grandfather Henry Raymond was in the 1841 census (plot 312, Higher Gunville, owned by Sir William Coles Medlycott Baronet). I'd like to have a look around the area where my Raymond family line lived before emigrating to South Australia in 1852.

Henry was the son of Morris aka Maurice Raymond, who is named in the story about Ruth Raymond (born 1799 Morris son of Avice and Henry).

Henry's 3-year-old brother James was buried 4 days after Henry was baptised in 1826. In 1828 his parents gave him a new brother, also named James. Morris died in 1840 and Henry's mother Elizabeth married Arthur Ansty in 1842. In the 1851 census 22 year old James was living with his mother and step-father in Gunville Street, while Henry and his wife Jane (nee Hamlen/Hamblen/ Hamblyn of Purse Caundle) lived next door, with their 1 year old daughter Emily.

In 1851 Elizabeth Ansty died and in 1852 Henry and Jane emigrated to South Australia on the Gloucester with little Emily, who died on the journey. They had already lost a little girl Emma in 1849. They went on to have twins (a girl and boy) in 1854, my great great grandfather John in 1858 and another daughter named Elizabeth in 1859.

Henry Raymond apparently died in about 1859 although there doesn't appear to be any official record of his death, he is just noted as 'deceased' on the birth certificate of his daughter Elizabeth. They had a farm in Clare here in South Australia and that's as far as I knew about my Raymond family history until I started to dig a bit more. Jane did have another son who was known as James Raymond but Henry wasn't his father.
